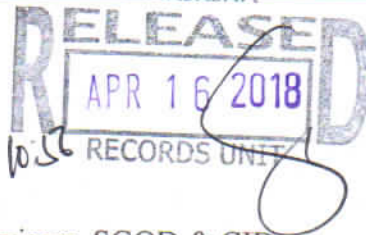



Greetings of peace!

The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) in coordination with the TDC-NCR Teachers' Athletic Association (TDC-NCRTAA) and its local chapters and member-schools within the National Capital Region (NCR) will again hold the *Summer Sports Festival for Teachers* from May 2 to 5, 2018. Dubbed as *PALARONG ATING GURO 2018*, the invitational sports event is now on its fifth year. The event's theme is *"Unity through sports, strengthening the teachers' movement through camaraderie."*

This sports event aims to foster camaraderie among the teachers, promote discipline and love for sports and give them a break from school routine this summer. Several competing groups representing TDC chapters from Metro Manila have initially confirmed their participation for several sporting events such as Men's Basketball, Women's Volleyball, Men's Volleyball, Badminton and Chess. For this year, TDC members and leaders unanimously chose Quezon City as the host chapter.

In this light, we would like to ask your good office to endorse the said event to the field and encourage the teacher to join the league. Furthermore, may we also request that this event be recommended to the Local School Board (LSB) to assist the participating teams and teacher-athletes as to the funding for their registration, uniform and other expenses. As per DBM-DepEd-DILG Joint Circular No. 1, 2017, funding for sports program may be charged against the LGUs' special education fund (SEF). Attached is the one-page "general rules" of the league for the reference of everyone.

General Rules for the TDC's Summer Sports Festival for Teachers 2018

1. The game is open to all NCR teachers and those interested teams from nearby regions. Any teacher, as long as she/he is certified by the Principal or Administrative Officer of the Division may join. Non-teaching staff assigned in schools and divisions may also join the event provided that they shall not comprise more than one player in team sports at any given time;
2. The management of the entire games shall be handled by the Technical Committee composed of TDC-NCRTAA officers and representatives of the competing teams/divisions. The committee is the highest decision-making body for the league and tasked to formulate specific rules for every event and resolve all issues relative to the games. Each competing team/division shall designate their representative to the Committee;
3. Registration fee (quota) shall be collected from each team or player and shall be the sole source of funds for the event and shall be used to defray expenses for hiring of game officials, purchase of trophies/medals, and other administrative and incidental expenses. The amount of registration for each event are as follows:

Men's Basketball	P5, 000 per team
Men's Volleyball	P4, 000 per team
Women's Volleyball	P4, 000 per team
Badminton	P250 per player
Chess	P150 per player
4. Submission of line-up/gallery/entry and payment of registration (quota) for all events is set on April 23-27, participants may submit said requirements to any of the officers of the TDC-NCRTAA or TDC Chapter officers in their respective division. The Technical Committee may scrutinize the submitted entries.
5. The tentative venue of the games and billeting of the participants is in Quezon City, specifically San Francisco High School, Quezon City Science High School and Judge Juan Luna High School.
6. A final meeting of all the NCR-TAA and Technical Committee is also set on April 27 to finalize the programs, game schedules, specific rules and all other concerns of the league. (Venue of the meeting to be announced.)
