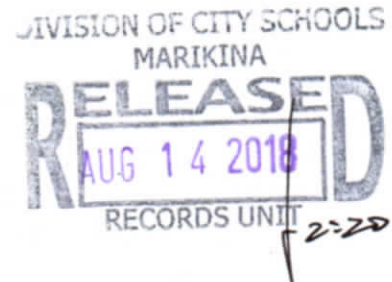

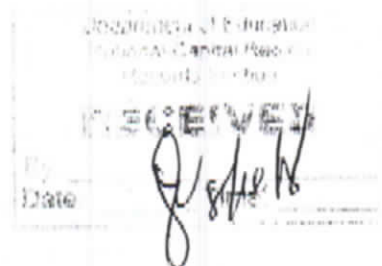

Grade 11-12 & Science Teachers - Scholars


The topics will be based on the least mastered skills based on the last Survey Tests.
