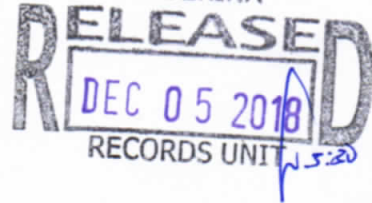

CHESS TRAINING TOURNAMENT

Attached is a letter from Ms. Marilou C. Lachita, Chief Umpire, Division Chess Group dated November 16, 2018 re: **Division Chess Training Tournament** for Grassroot Athletes, Developmental and Division Palaro Winners on December 8, 2018, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at Kalumpang National High School, content of which is self-explanatory, for information and guidance.

This activity is a follow up activity for the Chess Tournament Management Seminar and Organization dated March 27, 2018. All concerned teacher coaches who attended the said seminar are enjoined to be the officiating officials of the training tournament.

The following age groups will be observed:

- Elementary - Minimum Age: Born 2013, Maximum Age: Born 2006
- Secondary – Maximum Age: 2001

The main requirement needed for the participation of an athlete is *parental consent* which will be submitted before the conduct of the said event.

Expenses relative to the said event shall be charged to school canteen fund subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.

School heads are enjoined to support this worthy endeavor.
