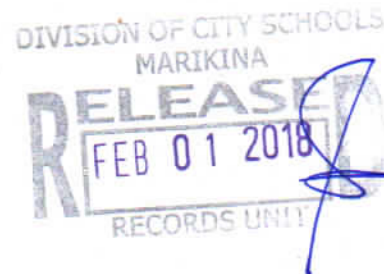



8th Word Cup Journalism Workshops & Contests Details of Registration

The 8th Word Cup Journalism Workshops & Contests will be held on April 23-25, 2018 at Faith Village Gardens Boracay Station 3, Malay, Aklan.

The journalism workshop aims to:

1. Further improve the writing skills of teachers and students;
2. Present a model layout and design for campus newspaper production;
3. Guide participants in the composition and delivery of a winning radio and TV script, and;
4. Recognize contest winners.

The intended participants of this workshop are students, school paper advisers, language and communications arts teachers, department heads and school heads. Contests are optional and open to elementary, junior and senior high school students and school paper advisers.

The seminar package prices are as follows:
