Information literacy is a crucial skill in the pursuit of knowledge. It involves recognizing when information is needed and being able to efficiently locate, accurately evaluate, effectively use, and clearly communicate information in various formats. It refers to the ability to navigate the rapidly growing information environment, which encompasses an increasing number of information suppliers as well as the amount supplied, and includes bodies of professional literature, popular media, libraries, the Internet, and much more. (Wesleyan University, n.d.)

Objectives:

- To inform the teachers regarding the importance of knowing and identifying misinformation like fake news and not credible sources
- To emphasize the roles of teachers in educating their students about misinformation like fake news and not credible sources
- To discuss the literacy skills and strategies that both the teachers and the students should develop (e.g. determining the nature and extent of the information needed, etc.)
- To apply these literacy skills and strategies not just in the classroom but also in their everyday lives
