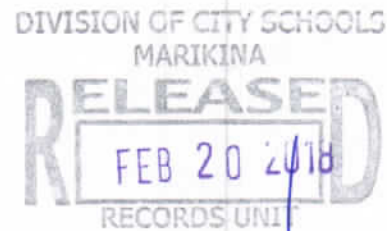

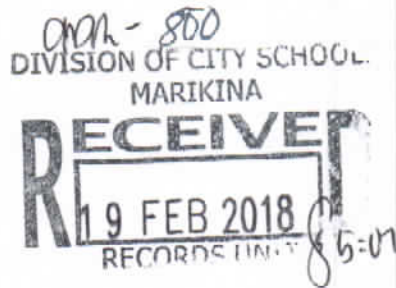

In this light, may we extend this project to DepEd Marikina by being our partner in Sayaw Pinoy Marikina.


