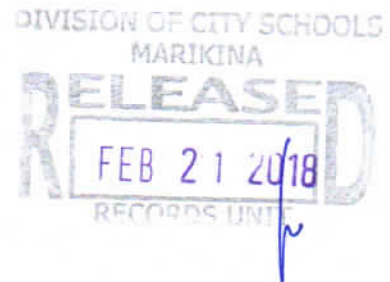

Greetings in Christ!

The Diocese of Antipolo Commission for Migrants and Itinerant People (DACMI) together with the CBCP's Episcopal Commission for the Pastoral Care of Migrants and Itinerant People (CBCP-ECMI) has a program known as **Sons and Daughters of OFW's Formation Program (SDOFP)**, being given to teachers, guidance counselors and the like to help support and manage the concerns of OFW children.

This SDOFP of CBCP-ECMI is already institutionalized in some of its partner dioceses nationwide. In our diocese, we too are encouraging schools to adopt the said program so it may be functional in the school level.

We already had our training of teachers and guidance counselors last year, and as part of our on-going efforts to support the OFW children, we are holding a **Congress for Anak-OFW, on 10 March, 8-5p.m. at the Antipolo National High School, Cogeo, Antipolo City.** This is an effort to initially unite OFW children on their concerns and come up with interventions which they too, think they need. This will also be highlighted by a **QUIZ BEE Contest**, the winners of which will represent the diocese in the regional level and eventually in the national level.

In this light, we invite your high schools to send at least ten (10) students per school, and amongst them select also at **least two (2) contestants** for the Quiz Bee Portion. We also request that you send a teacher with them.

We trust that you will be one with us in this endeavor as it aims to unite and empower our OFW children, and in so doing contribute to a peaceful and harmonious OFW families eventually.


We request the students to bring "baon" lunch. Merienda will be taken cared of by DACMI.
