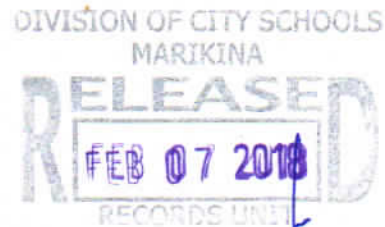

The actual interview and **AWARDING** will be on **10 February 2018** at the **Our Lady of Peace School (OLPS), Antipolo City**.


