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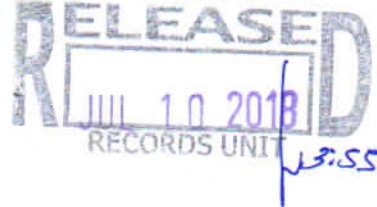

Target Participants:

SPG and SSG Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor, PRO) and the Members of the Pupil and Student Government Leaders of the Division and the Teacher-Advisers.

Overview and OBJECTIVES:

The Region Wide Pupil and Student Government and Teachers Advisers' Leadership Development Training is a three-day intensive program that emphasizes on necessary, beneficial and practical approaches to better leadership development and decision making. The intensive program will explore analytical frameworks employing the leadership strategies with proper decision making skills. Participants will build skills and refine values as they perform team's eco-challenge which will provide greater inspiration for the self to effect change in the families, communities and the nation.
