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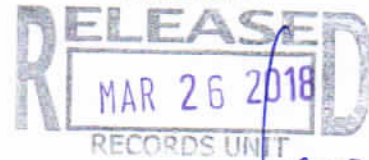

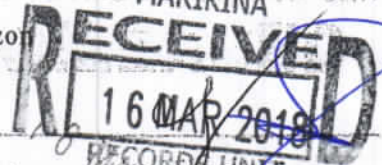


- 1) Traits, values, and skills of a library administrator;

This lecture is free and open to the public. It qualifies as a continuing professional development initiative under self-directed learning. Certificates of appearance will be issued as requested.


