

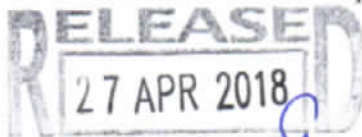

**1. BASIC TRAINING COURSE with AGE LEVEL SPECIALIZATION (BTC w/ ALS) -  
2-5 May**

**OBJECTIVES:** At the end of the course, the participants must have appreciated leadership in the Girl Scouting Movement; gained knowledge and skills that will stimulate them to recruit Girls, organize and run their Troops.

**Trainees:** TEACHERS, other ADULTS who are interested and willing to organize GSP TROOPS.

**2. CAMPERS PERMIT COURSE (CPC) – 2-6 MAY**

It is expected that after the course the trainees have acquired and demonstrated skills, knowledge, attitude, motivation to plan, organize and direct a Camp of not less than 120 campers.

**Trainees:** TEACHERS or TROOP LEADERS who have already taken the GSP Basic Training and Outdoor Leadership Courses

**3. OUTDOOR LEADERSHIP COURSE (OLC) – 2-8 MAY**

After the course, the attendees should have learned and demonstrated knowledge, skills, acquired attitude that will motivate them to plan, organize and run Troop Camps (12-40 girls).

**Trainees:** TEACHERS or TROOP LEADERS (those with GSP Troops) who have already taken the GSP Basic Course.

**4. CAMP MANAGEMENT COURSE (CMC) – 2-6 MAY**

It is aimed that after this, the trainees must have acquired knowledge, skills, attitude and appreciation to plan, organize and direct camp of not less than 200 Girls and Troop Leaders.

**Trainees:** TEACHERS or TROOP LEADERS who have already taken the GSP Basic Training, Outdoor Leadership and Campers' Permit Courses

**Time of arrival :** 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon

**Training Fee :** P3,800.00 BTC w/ ALS  
P4,000.00 OLC, CPC and CMC

This being an official business, Transportation can be charge to MOOE/Local Funds and Training Fees to GSP Funds, subject to the standard accounting and auditing procedures.

**Things to bring:**

- personal stuff, GSP uniforms, black shoes, physical fitness
- attire, eating utensils, light beddings, sleeping bag/bed roll, triangular bandage, writing and art materials (bond paper, folder and fastener, cartolina etc.),
- tent if possible.

Additional things to bring for CPC, OLC and CMC are:

- 15 pcs. Bamboos 1 yard x 1 inch.
- Twine

Only through your favorable endorsement and authority will this training be successful thus, we pray for your utmost consideration to send participants.
