



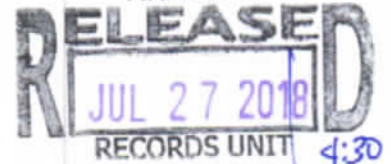

CORRIGENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 181, S. 2018

RE: DIVISION POPULATION QUIZ AND ON-THE-SPOT SKILLS COMPETITION

TO: Chief Education Supervisors, CID and SGOD
 Elementary and Secondary School Principals
 Officers-in-Charge
 Public and Private Schools

1. As per the new implementing guidelines for the 2019 National On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition on Population Development and the Regional Festival of Talents to be held on October 10-13 at SDO Manila, there will be some changes in the conduct of the **Division Population Quiz and On-the-Spot Skills Competition** on August 24, 2018 (Friday) 8:00 A.M. at Jesus dela Peña National High School:

- a. The following will be the areas for Population Development Competition, the grade level and the number of participants per event for the division level:

Category	Grade Level	Number of Participants
1. Pop Quiz	Junior and Senior High School	1
2. PopDev Debate	Junior and Senior High School	1
3. Jingle Writing and Singing	Junior and Senior High School	1
4. On the Spot Poster Making	Grades 4-6 (Elementary)	1
5. Kasaysayan, Heograpiya at Kultura ng Pilipinas Quiz	Grades 4-6 (Elementary)	1- Regular 1 - SPED

b. PopDev Debate Guidelines

- The event is a combination of argumentation and debate. It enables the contestant to use his critical analysis and deep reasoning about the different issues that occur in the society. This also develops the ability of the students to organize his ideals promptly and logically.
- Contestants shall be assigned a number that will correspond to the number on the judging sheet.
- Topics to be debated shall revolve on the following issues: country's foreign and economic policies, environment, gender and society, governance, peace and order, population and reproductive health, and other current / contemporary issues.
- The debater is required to use the English language as a medium except for terminologies on certain topics that are only stated in Filipino



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- The debate will consist of two rounds:

Round 1: Elimination Round

- Each debater will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes to deliver his/her speech on the topic
- After the discourse of each contestant, the judge will ask a question. The debater will be given a maximum of two (2) minutes to answer the question.

Round 2: Final Round

- After the first round, five (5) debaters will proceed to the second round. The debaters will be following the same order as the first round
- A new topic for debate will be given on the second round. The topics will also be selected from the issues enumerated previously from the second round.
- Each debater will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes to deliver his/her discourse on the topic
- After the discourse of the first contestant/debater, the second debater will interpolate on the speech of the first debater. The question for the Interpolation will focus on the arguments of the opponent. Categorical questions will be allowed (answerable by yes or no), however, the responder may choose to qualify or not his/her answer. A total of five (5) minutes will be allowed for other contestants to ask for their clarifications, rebuttal and other questions
- The second contestant will also give his/her discourse on the topic that will be given following the rules number 2.3 and 2.4. the third debater will be asking questions. Debater 3 will be asked by debater 4, debater 4 by debater 5 and debater 5 by debater 1.
- Prompting and coaching during the duration of the debate shall strictly be prohibited.
- The criteria for judging are:

DEBATE	PERCENTAGE
Delivery	20%
Use of supporting evidence	25%
Organization	25%
Reasoning and ability to answer	30%
TOTAL	100%

c. Kasaysayan, Heograpiya at Kultura ng Pilipinas Quiz

- The quiz is open to all types of learners who are officially enrolled in Grades 4-6
- There will be one (1) contestant per school for regular learners and another contestant for school with learners with disability such as those with seeing and hearing impairment, physically challenged, learners with autism and other who shall present valid MOV s upon registration.

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3. Test questions shall be based on Araling Panlipunan Grades 4-6 competencies.
 4. During the quiz, participants shall bring with them ¼ illustration board, chalk and eraser.
 5. Filipino shall be the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
 6. Participants shall be given a total of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are “easy”, seven (7) are “average”, and seven (7) are difficult”.
 7. Points for every correct answer shall be given as follows: One (1) point for “easy” question, two (2) points for “average” question, and three (3) points for “difficult” question. In case of a tie, a clincher question drawn from the “difficult” category shall be asked until a winner emerges.
 8. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds for easy, twelve (12) seconds for average, and fifteen (15) seconds for difficult round to answer the question.
 9. The quizmaster shall read each question twice. Countdown shall start after the question has been read the second time and the quizmaster says “GO”. When the quizmaster says “STOP” or “TIME IS UP”, contestants must raise their answer to the audience and to the Board of Judges until such time that the proctors have verified or confirmed the answer. Those who are unable to observe the instruction shall not earn a point.
 10. Should a contestant wish to change his/her answer that he/she has written down, this answer should be crossed out with horizontal line and the new answer should be written clearly above the crossed out answer. A contestant is allowed to change his/her answer within the time allotted for the particular question.
 11. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed:
 - a. Only the contestant or the official coaches are allowed to raise a protest or inquiry before the next question is read.
 - b. The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the chair of the board of judges.
 - c. The chair shall announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the board of judges.
 12. The decision of the Board of Judges is final
 - a. **There will be no National ASEAN Quiz this school year** so there will be no division and regional ASEAN Quiz.
