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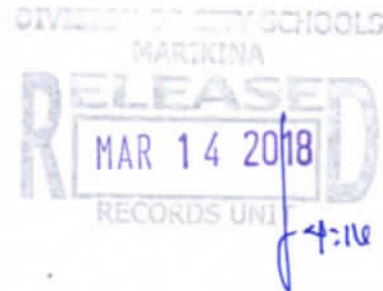

November 2017 Accreditation and Equivalency Examinees with Pending Results

1. As stipulated in the Department of Education Memorandum No. 164, s. 2017 entitled "Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test Registration and Administration," dated October 18, 2017, all the test applicants are required to submit a copy of the *birth certificate and any proof of identity*.
