



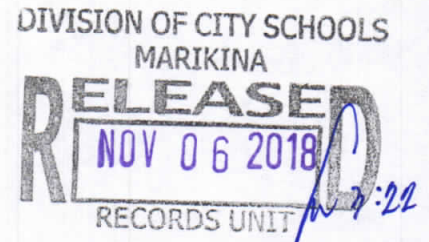

UPDATES IN THE 2018 DIVISION PALARO

In line with the 2nd Periodic Examination, there will be changes in the preliminary activities of 2018 Division Palaro. Hereunder are the following changes and updates, for information and guidance of all concerned:

- The **PATAFA Athletics School Tour Project** will commence on November 7, 2018 with only one session in the afternoon from 2:00 pm onwards at Parang Elementary School.
- **All concerned teacher screeners** are highly enjoined to convene on **November 7-9, 2018** at **Sta. Elena High School** for the **Second Wave of Screening Activities**. Only team coordinators are allowed in the screening venue.
- The **Technical Sports Meeting** which was originally scheduled on November 6, 2018 is reset on **November 8, 2018**, same time (8:00 am to 11:00 am) at **Concepcion Elementary School**.
- Likewise, the **Solidarity Meeting** which was originally scheduled on November 7, 2018 is reset on **November 8, 2018**, same time (2:00 pm onwards) at **Marikina High School**.
- The **venue** for the **2018 Cheerdancing Competition** which is slated on November 10, 2018 will be moved to **Sto. Niño National High School**.
- There will be **advanced games** for **ATHLETICS** on **November 12, 2018**. All concerned officiating officials are enjoined to perform their duties on the said date.

Please excuse all concerned teachers on the said dates. Student athletes should be given *make-up classes* and *activities* after the palaro. Necessary arrangement should be made regarding class schedules of concerned teachers to avoid disruption of classes.

Concerned school heads are highly enjoined to extend their cooperation in this endeavor
