



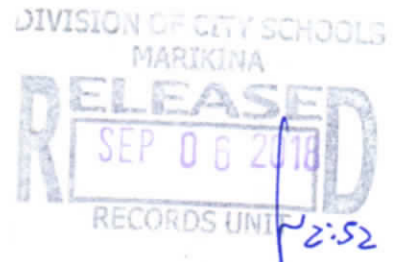

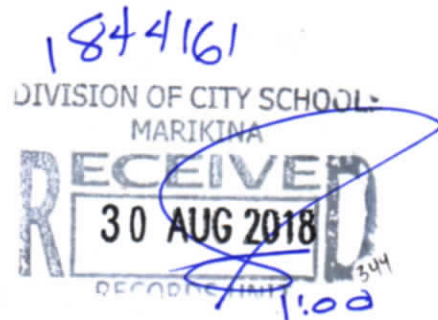

TITLE: "1st Sabayang Pagbigkas Competition"

In Celebration of the Red Cross Youth Month every October (Grade School, High School Students within PRC Marikina City Chapter Jurisdiction)

Date of Contest: October 13, 2018

Deadline of submission of entries: September 14, 2018

THEME: "Kahandaan ng Kabataan ay Mahalaga, Tungo sa Mas Matatag na Pamayanan"

I. BACKGROUND:

The Philippines is one of the most-disaster prone countries in the world and ranks second in South East Asia after Indonesia. Annual direct damage from disasters between 1997 and 2007 amount to PhP176,7 billion per year. Typhoons only affect the GDP by 0.5% annually¹. In the rural areas, families are highly dependent on small-scale or subsistence farming and fishing, sectors very vulnerable to disasters. Linked to climate change, extreme weather events have occurred more frequently since 1980. These extreme weather events have one thing in common - persistent torrential rains, causing landslides and flash floods, killing people and destroying property along its path. Environmental factors such as deforestation aggravate flood risks. The effects of loose soil and reduced forest cover from past forestry activities cause frequent landslides and flashfloods.

The International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, born of a desire to bring assistance without discrimination to the wounded on the battlefield, endeavors - in its international and national capacity - to prevent and alleviate human suffering wherever it may be found. Its purpose is to protect life and health and to ensure respect for the human being. It promotes mutual understanding, friendship, co-operation and lasting peace amongst all peoples.

This year's theme of the celebration is "**Kahandaan ng Kabataan ay Mahalaga, Tungo sa Mas Matatag na Pamayanan**". The theme emphasizes the role of all the youth in the implementation of National disaster Risk Reduction Law (RA 10121). In order for us to achieve national solidarity, each stakeholder, from the various government agencies, academe, non - government organizations and the public in general, must have a clear understanding of their functions and roles in effectively implementing the Law.

OBJECTIVES:

- ♣ To strengthen awareness on the importance of disaster resilience
- ♣ To showcase the talents of public and private elementary and high school students, and recognize their creative skills.
- ♣ To gain advocates of disaster resilience and Red Cross Movement
- ♣ To create friendship and solidarity among youth as one of the objectives of the Red Cross

II. MECHANICS

1. Who can join:

- The contest is open to Filipino children, ages 6 to 25 at the date of the contest.
- The contest is open to all Elementary and High School Students and Marikina City Chapter Community Red Cross Youth volunteers. Senior High School will be considered as High School Category.
- Must be a bonafide RCY member of any RCY Council within the jurisdiction of Marikina City.
- Participants must have a Red Cross Membership Accidental Assistance Benefits.

2. The main theme of the contest is:

“Kahandaan ng Kabataan ay Mahalaga, Tungo sa Mas Matatag na Pamayanan”

All entries must include the aforementioned theme

3. Entry

- Every School is allowed to send a minimum of 20 and maximum of 30 participants (including props-men and support personnel).
- The participants are given a minimum of 3mins and maximum of 5mins period to finish their presentation.
- Using of sound effects, props, video play are prohibited and will result to deduction of points (10 points), only costume, body paint and human sounds will be allowed to be used by all participants.
- Only School with RCY council can join the contest.
- All entries will present according to the agreed number of presentation.

4. Proper use of Red Cross Emblem (if it will be used on props during presentation)

Basic Rules:

1. The red cross and red crescent must always be in plain solid red. Their shapes must not be altered.
2. The cross and crescent must always appear on a white background. No variations, not even beige or grey shading, are allowed.
3. No lettering, design or object should be superimposed on the white background or on the cross or crescent itself.
4. The cross, the crescent must be two dimensional, not three dimensional.
5. The cross, the crescent may not be used in series as a border, a repetitive decoration, typographic embellishment or shown as a drawing in perspective.

5. Criteria for judging shall be:

Creativity and presentation	- 20%
Synchronization	- 20%
Voice Quality	- 50%
Coordination with the Piece	- 10%

Total - 100%

- Late comers will be deducted 5 points from the total points accumulated.
- Any misuse of logos under the RA 10530 in the rules using the Red Cross, Red Crescent and misinterpretation of the International Humanitarian Law (IHL) will be an automatic 5% Deduction to the total number of points.

6. Who will judge the contest

- The entries will be judged by a Board of Judges, composed of Red Cross Staff from Headquarters, Board of Director from Marikina City Chapter and Academe Sector.
- The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and non-appealable. Any administrative or technical problems that may arise during the contest shall be resolved by the PRC, whose decision, moreover, shall be final and non-appealable.

7. The prizes, shall be:

Plaque, Certificate of appreciation/participation (participant & school)

8. Rights:

Winning and other entries shall become the properties of the Philippine Red Cross – Marikina City Chapter IHL and Dissemination Office, and may be used for its continuing advocacy campaigns on disaster resiliency.

9. Registration:

Interested and qualified contestants must register using the attached Registration Form on or before September 14, 2018.
