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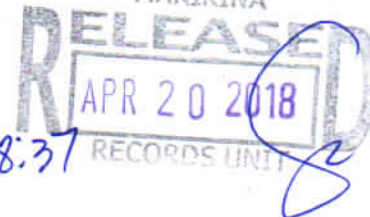

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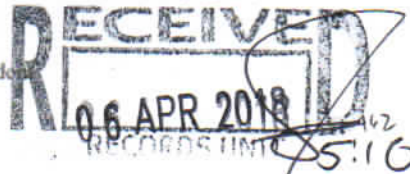

Our target participants are public and private school administrators, ALS and reading supervisors, teachers / schools and hub librarians, reading teachers (English/Filipino) writers, reading enthusiasts and ALS implementers. Participants will be charged P5,500.00 (Live-In) and P5,000.00 (Live-Out) 3 nights' accommodation at the venue (for live-in only) 3 breakfast, 3 Lunch and 3 dinners, 6 snacks, bag, CD copy of the seminar papers presented and certificate of appearance / active participation.
