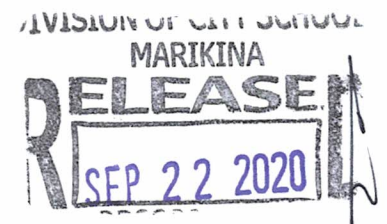


WEBINAR ON BUILDING RESILIENCE FOR REMOTE MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE TEACHING AND LEARNING
