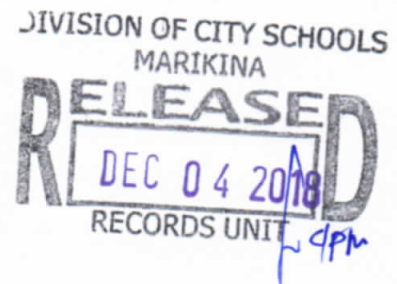

WHEREAS, it is prudent that a day of each year be set aside to celebrate and honor these teachers for their altruistic devotion on teaching and invaluable guidance on students;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF MARIKINA, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. The City Government of Marikina extends the appropriate honors and recognition to all Marikina City teachers owing to their lasting and meaningful contributions to the lives of students and the city.

SECTION 2. Every second Friday of December of every year is set aside to be known and celebrated as Marikina Teachers' Day, which is a "no classes" day for all academic institutions.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


