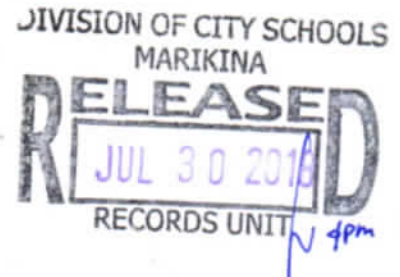

**CONDUCT OF RANDOM DRUG TESTING
IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS**

In line with the National Drug Education Program (NDEP) and pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2017, Guidelines for the Conduct of Random Drug Testing in Public and Private Secondary Schools, the Department of Education (DepEd) will be conducting the random drug testing among public secondary students nationwide.

For the efficient implementation of the drug testing activities in schools, this Office enjoins the Secondary School Heads/Officers In-Charge to conduct a re-orientation to students and parents on the guidelines for the conduct of Random Drug Testing. The attached notification letter for the parents will be distributed during the orientation. In relation to this, please prepare the masterlist of Grade 7 to 12 students in Excel format, continuous number and alphabetically arranged using the attached template (printed and soft copy) to be submitted at the Division Office on or before August 10, 2018 together with the Attendance Registry during the conduct of the Re-orientation.
