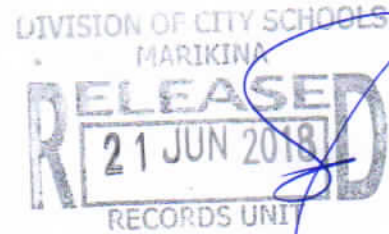

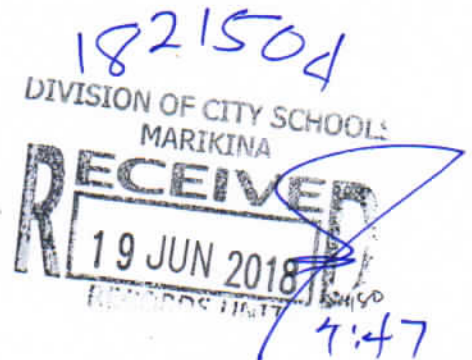
We hope that this humble initiative will help the education sector as we all seek for clarifications on several matters in relation to our respective roles in this department.
