
The Philippine Science High School System (PSHSS) is a government school system which annually conducts a National Competitive Examination (NCE) for grade six students who are intellectually and financially deserving. It offers a student who passes this examination a free grade 7 – 12 education, a monthly socialized stipend and free loan of available books.

This year, this much awaited NCE among more than 20,000 applicants will be held on **October 20, 2018** all over the Philippines. In connection to this, the Philippine Science High School Main Campus (PSHS MC) has been tasked to conduct an NCE Caravan for the NCR schools.

We intend to conduct the NCE Caravan in your region from **June 25 to August 31, 2018**, if you will allow us. For this matter, may we request your permission and assistance to grant us an authorization letter and to advise your school superintendents and principals to expect our visits to your public schools. Some of our faculty and administrative staff will need to meet the upper ten percent of your schools – to orient them, give and collect their NCE application forms before the September 21, 2018 deadline.
