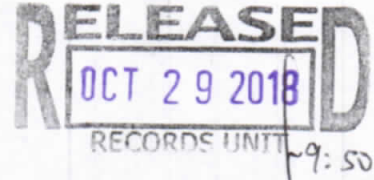


*ACES – Athletics School Coaches, Transition Teacher Coaches and Trainers

We are very pleased getting your agreement to be part of the two above initiatives.

Further to the initial information we have provided you, we are glad to furnish you additional details.

Athletics Coaching Enhancement System (ACES)

Dates: 2-5 November 2018
Venue: Philsports Arena (formerly Ultra), Pasig City
Activity type: 4-day seminar with written test and practical evaluation

This 4-day short-course is aimed to advance the technical competency and practical knowledge of physical education teachers and local coaches handling young and developmental athletes for athletics. **The seminar is free of charge. There will be NO registration fee to be collected.**

In appreciation of Marikina's proactive partnership in the implementation of the subsequent Athletics School Tour, we are allotting 30 slots for the Division of Marikina to field participants from their area for this seminar.

The first three days of the seminar will be comprised by two sessions, one in the morning (to start promptly at 8am and finish at 12nn) and one in the afternoon (from 1pm to 5pm). The fourth day of the seminar will have the participants undertake a practical evaluation in the morning and take a written test in the afternoon. Composite ratings from the practical evaluation and written test will make up the final rating of participants. The overall band score of a participant will range from 1.0 to 10.0. Only participants earning a 6.0 band or higher shall be given an ACES Certificate of Completion.

Athletics School Tour Marikina leg

Date: 7 November 2018
Venue: Malanday Elementary School and Parang Elementary School
Activity type: School visit with short talk and presentation and physical activity for the school children

The key intent of this initiative is to provide information to schoolchildren (grades 4 to 6) of the benefits and fun of actual engagement in regular physical activity and the sports of Athletics. Each of the two schools nominated by the partner schools division will be visited in the morning (9-11am) and afternoon (2-4pm), respectively. The school visit will only entail 1 hour for a general assembly of the Grades 4 to 6 school children for which the outlined program will take place. After the short talk and presentation program, we will proceed with an Athletics-based physical activity, a modified version of the Kids' Athletics Games, for the children where they will be engaged to run, jump, and throw in a novel and safe way.

For this activity, we would like to request your good office for a suitable venue with an adequate sound system augmented with a projector and projection screen.

We look forward to the successful implementation of these projects with your good office.
